8 **POINTING TO THE CROSS**

- One and only son

- The region of Moriah (traditionally assoc. with Jerusalem)
 - The third day
 - The burden bearer
 - God's provision of the sacrifice & substitutionary atonement
 - Guest appearance by the Angel of the Lord
 - Jehovah Jireh
 - Blessing incl. victory over enemies
- "Through your offspring..."
- Abrahamic Covenant fulfilled in Christ

9 **ROMANS 8:31-32**
