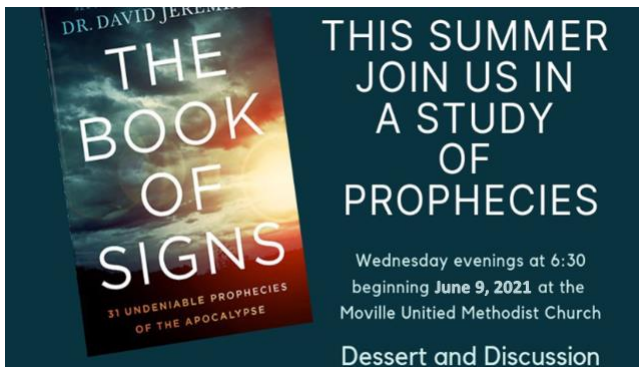

**Scripture****Mark 5: 21-34**

<sup>21</sup> As soon as Jesus had returned by boat to the other shore, a large crowd gathered round him. While he was by the lakeside, <sup>22</sup> there came a synagogue president named Jairus; and when he saw him, he threw himself down at his feet <sup>23</sup> and pleaded with him. 'My little daughter is at death's door,' he said. 'I beg you to come and lay your hands on her so that her life may be saved.'<sup>24</sup> So Jesus went with him, accompanied by a great crowd which pressed round him.

<sup>25</sup> Among them was a woman who had suffered from hemorrhages for twelve years; <sup>26</sup> and in spite of long treatment by many doctors, on which she had spent all she had; she had become worse rather than better. <sup>27</sup> She had heard about Jesus, and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak; <sup>28</sup> for she said, 'If I touch even his clothes, I shall be healed.'<sup>29</sup> And there and then the flow of blood dried up and she knew in herself that she was cured of her affliction. <sup>30</sup> Aware at once that power had gone out of him, Jesus turned round in the crowd and asked, 'Who touched my clothes?' <sup>31</sup> His disciples said to him, 'You see the crowd pressing round you and yet you ask, 'Who touched my clothes?'' <sup>32</sup> But he kept looking around to see who had done it. <sup>33</sup> Then the woman, trembling with fear because she knew what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and told him the whole truth. <sup>34</sup> He said to her, 'Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace, free from your affliction.'
