

How to Maintain your Witness in a Hostile World Holiness Amidst Suffering: An Exposition of First Peter 1 Peter 3:13-17

Central Idea: Maintaining one's Christian witness in the face of hard opposition can be extremely tough. Therefore, in 1 Peter 3:13-17, the Apostle provides us with six principles for maintaining an effective Christian witness in a hostile world.

- I. Be a **zealot** for what is good (3:13).
- II. Do not be **intimidated** (3:14).
- III. <u>Set apart</u> Christ as Lord in your hearts (3:15a).
- IV. Be **prepared** to defend the faith (3:15b).
- V. Keep your **conscience** clear (3:16).
- VI. Suffer for the **Savior** rather than for sin (3:17).
