An Exposition of Psalm 119:1-8

Central Idea: Every January, as the New Year ushers itself upon us, professing Christians tend to make “firm resolutions” to spend more time in the word of God; and every year, almost without fail, their newfound habit disappears before the first of February. In this grand Psalm, the psalmist provides no less than five reasons every believer should make God’s word a top priority in 2022.

- I. God’s Word Produces Happiness (119:1-2).
- II. God’s Word Produces Holiness (119:3-4).
- III. God’s Word Produces Humility (119:5-6).
- IV. God’s Word Produces Homage (119:7).
- V. God’s Word Produces Helplessness (119:8).
